Read and sign all forms in this packet and return to the Queen Coordinators by the deadline of 5 PM on Saturday, June 1, 2024 at Orientation, which will be mandatory for all applicants. Time to be determined Applications may be submitted by mail or hand delivered to the address below.

Parents must sign waivers for girls under the age of 18. The itinerary and schedule for the contest will be given as we get closer to the contest.

Parents and supporters are invited. Cameras are OK. Order of go for the contests will be drawn randomly.

This contest has two parts, scored by the judges at 50% each for personality and horsemanship. Please ask any questions you might have prior to beginning each segment of the contest. **Judges' decisions are final.**

- A. For personality segment, each girl should have a Modern-day western outfit, this may include western dress, skirt, pants, all accompanied with cowboy hat, and boots. All shirts or tops must be long sleeved. and collared. Each Queen and Princess candidate will give a 3-minute memorized speech about herself or Santa Fe, and what inspires her the most. There will then be a brief modeling session. Each girl will answer impromptu questions and have a brief personal interview with the judges. Questions can range from application, speech, PRCA rodeo, animal welfare, Santa Fe, current news, etc.
- B. Following the personality phase of the contest (This is subject to change) we will move on to the Horsemanship portion of the contest. There will be three phases for this part.
- 1. Horsemanship pattern (provided in application packet) Dressed in long sleeved white shirts, Scarves or jewelry accents is allowed, black or blue Wrangler jeans (PRCA sponsor) and cowboy hat. Secure your hat to your head (Royalty never lose their hats). Once set pattern is finished Trot over to the judges stop and dismount for additional questions, re-mount and exit arena.

(The judges reserve the right to ask for additional tasks i.e., swapping horses, verbal patterns, etc.)

2.Free style ride of your choosing.

Do not exceed 2 minutes. Be creative, show yourself and your horses' strengths and abilities. (Bareback riding, Roman riding, barrel/pole patterns will not be allowed as well as no music.)

3.Queen's run, keeping your horse controlled, waving, and smiling. Flag run. Be sure your horse can safely carry a flag prior to the contest.

Santa Fe Rodeo Queen, Princess and Sweetheart Contest Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations will apply to ALL contestants in the Santa Fe Rodeo Queen and Princess Contest.

- 1. Any female who is a Santa Fe County resident or resides within a 100-mile radius of Santa Fe County, between the ages of 13-25 years of age. The contestant has never been married and is childless. Candidate must agree to remain single and childless until the end of her reign. Should marriage or pregnancy occur during her reign, the title and all awards will automatically be relinquished to the First Alternate.
- 2. Contestants should wear western attire. This may include western dresses, skirts, pants, and jeans. All outfits must be accompanied by a cowboy hat and boots. All shirts or tops must be long sleeved and collared.
- 3. Judging will be on personality, appearance, horsemanship, style, and grace. If a tie should occur, the break will be based on a high score for the Horsemanship portion of the contest. This tie breaker is for the overall Title, NOT each category. Decision of the Judge(s) is final.
- 4. The Queen, Princess and Sweetheart will be expected to act and represent themselves appropriately always during their reign in and out of Royalty Attire as an ambassador for Rodeo de Santa Fe and the Western lifestyle. Inappropriate conduct may include but is not limited to smoking, drinking alcohol, use of illegal and/or non-prescribed drugs, fighting, or the use of profanity or being disrespectful to any member of our board or any other board or official in where you are attending a rodeo. Inappropriate behavior may result in the title being pulled with or without warning.
- 5. The Queen, Princess and Sweetheart must be available for Rodeo de Santa Fe events year-round per the coordinator, sometimes with short notice, the entire week of Rodeo de Santa Fe in June, Rodeo and Community promotion activities. Representation at said events will be mandatory. If the Queen, Princess or Sweetheart are unable to attend, they must communicate with the coordinator in advance. All events will be coordinated with the Queen Coordinator.
- 6. The Queen, Princess and or Sweetheart can find events for them to attend as well after discussing with the coordinator.

Santa Fe Rodeo Queen, Princess and Sweetheart Responsibilities

The following responsibilities will apply to the Santa Fe Rodeo Royalty Court. Any violations may result in the title being pulled with all awards and will automatically relinquish to the First Alternate.

- 1. A. The Queen is responsible for representing the Rodeo de Santa Fe and any other events which may come up throughout the year. Including but not limited to PRCA Rodeos around the states.
 - B. The Princess and Sweetheart will represent at all local events along side the Queen and if necessary, when the Queen is traveling to other PRCA Rodeo's
- 2. Royalty court will consist of the reigning Queen, Princess and Sweetheart. When wearing the sash and/or crown the Queen/Princess MUST be in proper Western Attire.
- 3. The Queen and Princess will represent Rodeo de Santa Fe at the following events in full dress code:
 - $^{\bullet}$ Rodeo de Santa Fe Rodeo 4 performances and any other events needed by the coordinator.
 - Fiesta Parade if available
 - Rodeo and Community Promotion Activities (County Commissioners & City Council Meetings, Radio Interviews, Live Remotes, etc.)
 - New Mexico State Fair Rodeo Grand Entry/Parade
- 4. The Queen, Princess and Sweethheart shall preside at any rodeo activities, county activities or county 4-H activities in full dress code* when called upon.
- 5. The Queen, Princess, Sweetheart and their parents will be responsible for assisting with the following year contest. Setting up and tearing down and including acquisition of awards and sponsorships.
- 6. The Queen, Princess and Sweetheart will be responsible for handing out posters, bumper stickers and rodeo promotional material.
- 7. If Royalty chooses to get chaps, they will be required to either find a sponsor or coordinate a fundraiser to raise money for the purchase. If possible and we have the funds, the Royalty Fund may be able to help. Parker Saddlery will be used for all chap purchases.

*Western Attire, full dress code includes long-sleeved, tucked in shirt, western jeans, skirt, or nice slacks, crown, buckle and sash, western hat & boots. Function appropriate
